Suzanne Clark is President of the Chamber of Commerce of the United States, the largest business federation in the world. She is the first female President in the institution's 104-year history.

Ms. Clark leads the strategic alignment and execution of policy development, government relations and market innovation in the quarter-billion-dollar organization. She also guides the strategic transformation of the Chamber's policies and processes to best meet the 21st century needs of its more than 3 million member companies internationally.

Prior to re-joining the US Chamber in 2014, where she had previously served as Chief Operating Officer, Clark acquired and led a prominent financial information boutique – Potomac Research Group (PRG) – which was recognized by the *Inc500* as the 135th fastest growing private company in 2012. As a seasoned

business owner, Ms. Clark remains passionate about the need to create an environment where companies can innovate, grow and flourish.

Clark sits on the Board of two public companies – AGCO, a *Fortune 500* global leader in the design, manufacture and distribution of agricultural equipment, and TransUnion, a provider of global risk and credit information.

Ms. Clark earned a BA, *magna cum laude*, and an MBA from Georgetown University, and lives in Virginia with her husband and their daughter.
